
WIFI: Eduroam

- Eduroam: The wireless network at UCPH. You can access eduroam with your UCPH username and password.
- Eduroam also gives you internet access at other faculties and at universities in other countries.
- Find the guide for setting up the network at:



Introduction to the Faculty of Social Sciences

- The Faculty of Social Sciences: In Danish it is called Center for Sundhed & Samfund = CSS
- The Faculty is located in the city centre of Copenhagen and used to be a hospital up until 1999
- Approx. 6500 students at CSS



Student-ID card

- To order your student ID card, you need to go to the <u>"Self Service"</u> via KUnet. Select: ID card -> Upload photo for ID card.
- Upload a photo of yourself in Self Service

If you have a foreign address or name/address protection

- When your ID card is ready, you will receive an e-mail in your KUmail with more information about how to collect your student ID card at South Campus. Your ID card will be ready in about 3-4 weeks.
- You collect the card in the Southern Campus at Amager, UCPH

If you have a Danish address

• The ID card will be send directly to you if you already have a Danish Address. Your ID card will be ready in about 3-4 weeks.

The Danish Grading System

7-point grading scale		
12	For an excellent presentation	Α
10	For a very good presentation	В
7	For a good presentation	С
4	For a fair presentation <u>containing some</u> major weaknesses	D
02	For a presentation meeting only the minimum requirements for acceptance	E
00	For a presentation not meeting the minimum requirements for acceptance	Ex
-3	For a presentation that is unacceptable in all respects	F

NB: some courses have pass (B)/ fail (I) examination

NB: You have 3 attempts for each exam

- You have 3 attempts for each of your exam
- For some courses, you have to meet specific prerequisites and/or requirements before taking exams. You can see the relevant prerequisites and/or requirements at courses.ku.dk
- The format might change at the re-exam (see courses.ku.dk)
- You are automatically signed up for your first attempt
- You can register for re-exams during the exam registration period (see KUnet) through self service – ONLY applies to MSc in Economics

Examples of plagiarism

- Refers to the unacknowledged use of someone else's ideas. You should at all times present your own work for the exams
- Remember to give correct references (sources) for all quotations, ideas and arguments from other sources including yourself (Always use the style of citation and quotation outlined for the different departments)
- All papers are checked in an international plagiarism check system
- You will get suspended from the exam, and possibly for the UCPH aswell
- The rules are listed on KUnet (follow the path: Kunet → study information → Exams → Exam cheating)

Group Exams

- Each student's performance is assessed on an individual basis, and individual grades are awarded.
- Each student's contribution must be indicated in the table of contents as well as at the beginning of the respective sections of the assignment that the student has authored.



- Physical or mental illness/functional impairment such as dyslexia, vision problems, stress, concussion, ADHD.
- Temporary challenges such as pregnancy or linguistic challenges.

Apply for exemption through KUnet. Remember to attach documentation


